


VITALIANO'S FARM HISTORY

You can easily see how Vitaliano's eyes bright up when he talks about his farm and his coffee. Vitaliano Merino is 70 years old and he doesn't only love coffee, but he is a coffee grower that stands out for his amazing quality. He was the winner of the Bracamoros Cup in 2017, an event in which they tribute the best 100 producers in the region and incentivize the production of specialty coffee in the country. Bracamoros Coffee, the name of the event, honors the very first inhabitants of this small town. Bracamoros were a diversity of amazonic ingenous tribe groups who settled in the borders of rio Mayo-Chinchipe, in the province of Zamora. This event, counts with the participation of the best specialty coffee producers from the region with their organic and conventional lots.


